## MINUTES

**25. Apologies**

Cllr Margaret Rickard tendered apologies which were received and approved.  
Cllr Landymore was absent.

**26. Declarations of Interest**

There were no declarations for which dispensations had not been duly authorised.

**27. Public Forum**

No matters were raised.

**28. Planning Application DC/17/1267/FUL**

The above application was introduced by the Chair. A representative of the applicant spoke and explained the context of and reasons for the application and also made reference to the value of local rural businesses.

In lengthy discussion a wide variety of issues was discussed, including the likely level of additional traffic, the siting of the dwelling, the flood risk and likely impact of any flooding and the views of nearby residents recorded on the Planning Authority online portal.

At the end of the discussion the Chair called for a vote and it was unanimously agreed to support the application.

**29. B4RN Broadband**

Cllr Varney reported the discussion of the working party, established by the previous meeting, and on other research and discussions. After discussion it was resolved to approve, as Custodian Trustee, the use of the Erskine Centre site for the positioning of a repeater station, subject to the Community Council supporting the proposal and consideration of the contract and wayleave documentation.
